Full PPE including gloves and SCBA (on air) shall be utilized throughout skill.</p> <p>*IPS will be successful if completed with a score of 80% or above without any critical failures. *</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>**Add 30 seconds for each 100' of hose beyond first 100' extension **</b></p>
