1. Acknowledges order from Officer		
2. Spots apparatus as directed to facilitate portable tank deployment and draft site setup		
3. Sets the parking brake		
4. Exits cab		
5. Assists in draft site setup		
6. Works with CO/FF to set up the draft sight (jet siphon or the low-level strainer, hard suction hose, etc.)		
7. Assists in connection of drafting equipment to Attack Pumper (as necessary)		
8. When directed by the water supply officer, empties Tender tank into closest portable tank for use during attack operations.		
9. Remounts apparatus (with crew) and proceeds to the nearest water supply source as directed by water supply officer or command. (criteria used in the determination of viability may include: proximity; water quality; volume needed; and traffic patterns).		
10. Spots apparatus as directed (Allowing for efficient hose deployment, traffic hazards and placement/movement of other key apparatus).		
11. Sets the parking brake		
12. Exits cab		
13. Sets wheel chocks (as appropriate)		
14. Works with CO/FF to establish supply from the identified source utilizing one section of LDH and the portable hydrant. (Utilization of the portable hydrant will provide facilitate quicker refill for mutual aid agencies)		
15. Works with crew to mark fill site with traffic cones and/or request additional traffic control measures as necessary, to include either additional apparatus or PD units.		
16. Works with CO (as directed) to confirm with Command or Water Supply Officer that supply has been established, identifying the location of the fill site.
