Full PPE including gloves and SCBA shall be utilized throughout skill.</p> <p><b>**IPS will be successful if completed with a score of 80% or above without any critical failures. **</b></p>

7. *Throws ladder from high shoulder to vertical on the beam. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Watches the tip for overhead obstructions/hazards</li> <li>- Ensures firefighters final position is on halyard side, with fly facing objective.</li> </ul>	Pass / Fail	Pass / Fail
8. *Extends Ladder <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Secures beam with foot/leg</li> <li>- Extends fly section to correct height (As necessary)</li> <li>- Ensures dogs are locked before releasing halyard</li> </ul>	Pass / Fail	Pass / Fail
9. *Lowers ladder into objective in a controlled manner. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Ensures ladder tip is at correct height for intended use</li> </ul>	Pass / Fail	Pass / Fail
10. *Prepares ladder for climbing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Adjusts climbing angle</li> <li>- Ties-off halyard (if applicable)</li> <li>- Ensures tip is secure</li> <li>- Ensures dogs are locked</li> <li>- Ensures heels are on stable footing</li> <li>- Ensures ladder is properly footed prior to climbing</li> </ul>	Pass / Fail	Pass / Fail
